Immunization FAQ's for 2020-2021 school year

In compliance with NYS immunization mandates, all students (distance, hybrid and in person) are required to be fully immunized or hold a valid medical exemption form by September 21, 2020 in order to continue to attend Longwood Schools.

1. What if I cannot get an appointment with my pediatrician by 9/21/20?

We are able to accept proof of appointment (on Dr letterhead) for appointments prior to 10/2/20 with proof of immunization due on 10/2/20.

2. Why does my child need to be immunized if he/she is a full time distance learner and not in the building?

*This is not a Longwood decision, NYS requires that all students **registered** at Longwood need to be immunized to be enrolled as per NYS health law. <https://www.health.ny.gov/publications/2222.pdf>*

3. Where can I go to get immunizations if I cannot get an appointment with my pediatrician, so that I can be in compliance with NYS laws and my child is not excluded from school? (with health insurance)
