#### Required documents:

- Original birth certificate.
- Immunization records (see reverse side).
- Proof of residency: Town of Brookhaven Tax Bill, Deed, Mortgage Statement, Lease with two (2) current bills, or district's signed Affidavit of Landlord with copy of landlord's tax bill, available at Central Registration.
- · Custody Papers if applicable.

THE REGISTRATION PROCESS IS NOT COMPLETE UNTIL ALL MANDATORY DOCUMENTATION HAS BEEN SUBMITTED. YOU WILL RECEIVE A CONFIRMATION E-MAIL FROM OUR CENTRAL REGISTRATION OFFICE.

# Medical Requirements School Year 2019-2020

In order to have your child registered for Kindergarten for the Fall of 2019, the following items must be completed:

## 1. The following required immunizations must be done:

- Four or more doses of DTP.\*
- Three or more doses of Polio vaccine.\*
- Two doses of measles , mumps, rubella vaccine:
  - The first dose administered after 12 months of age
- Two doses of varicella vaccine:
  - Administered after 12 months of age.
- Three doses of Hepatitis B.\*

2. Proof of immunization must be <u>signed</u> and <u>stamped</u> by your child's physician.

## 3. For School Entrance in September:

- > The physical examination must be performed within one (1) year prior to the first day of school and Physical Form returned to School Health Office with physician's signature and stamp.
- 4. NYS requests that students enrolling in pre-kindergarten, kindergarten or first grade in a New York State public elementary school present a dental health certificate; such dental health certificate must contain a report of a comprehensive dental examination performed on such child.

For information regarding immunizations, or school physicals, please contact your family physician or the Elementary School Health Office.
